Masterplan

Your Reflection is a temporary installation built by the architects Guillermo Hevia García + Nicolás Urzúa Soler in the Araucano Park, in the city of Santiago. The pavilion is the winning project of the Young Architects Program 2016, an annual collaboration between the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) and The MoMA PS1 that fosters innovation in design and promotes emerging talents.

As the architects explained, the project is a pavilion designed to support the development of a series of cultural

activities including concerts, live music or stagings; all open to the public and free.

The first operation of the project was the definition of a support, or topography, a landscape with smooth mounds, covered in grass and spongy vegetation, colored by an infinite number of wild flowers, and crossed by a small creek.

The second operation was the insertion of three mirrored aluminum bi-dimensional planes, which built a series of inside and outside spaces,

eliminating the limits and making the object disappear; letting reflections of the surrounding become the real project.

The project was conceived to change the focus of the proposal from the object to the experience of the subject: its interaction with others and with the context; reflected and deformed. The intention of the designers was to create a project that was not closed but rather articulating a universe of sensations and experiences open to many interpretations.
